Mums and Daughters Talk (puberty)

I am writing to invite mums and daughters from all junior year groups to join our Parent Support Advisor, Carol Roberston, on **Wednesday 7th June at 6.00pm** at the junior school for a session on puberty.

Carol will be making a presentation and talking about puberty, starting with how girls' bodies change during puberty and moving on to the female reproductive system and menstrual cycle. She will also talk about the variety of sanitary products available in our shops today.

The talk is open to mums and daughters from all year groups in the junior school but we would like to make you aware that you must decide if you feel it is appropriate for your own child. I highly recommend the session to you, but girls mature at very different ages and therefore, whilst we feel the talk is most appropriate for girls in Years 5 and 6, it may be appropriate for some of our girls in lower school but perhaps not all of them.
