Dear Parents,

### Curriculum enrichment activities – infant school – autumn term 2017

The curriculum enrichment clubs are being run in the autumn term week beginning Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September until Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December. The activities on offer are:

- *Football*, run by SCL, Mondays 3.00pm to 4.00pm – for children in **Years 1 and 2**. This will be based in the junior hall and the children are walked to the junior school by a member of SCL staff.
- *Cookery*, run by Mrs Clarkson, Higher Level Teaching Assistant, Mondays 3.00pm – 4.00pm – for children in **Year 2 only**. This club will run in the infant hall. **Spaces are limited to 12.**
- *Arts and crafts*, run Mrs Toms and Mrs Nelson-Williams, Learning Support Assistants, Tuesdays 3.00pm to 4.15pm – for children in **Years 1 and 2**.
- *Recorder club*, run by Mrs Clarkson and Miss Matson, Wednesday 8.00pm – 8.30am - for children in **Year 2**. Each child will need his/her own recorder and recorder book which you will be able to buy from school (cost - recorder £6.00 and book £3.60). There will be a beginner session at the infant school and an advanced group at the junior school. Both groups are open to infant and junior children. If your child is interested in this club you will be informed which group your child should attend. You will also be informed when your child is ready to progress to the advanced group.
- *Gymnastics*, run by Basingstoke Gymnastics, Tuesdays 3.00pm, to 4.00pm on the junior school site – for children in **Year 2**. We welcome junior children to this club too. The children are walked to the junior school by a member of Basingstoke Gymnastics staff. **Spaces at this club are strictly limited to 16.**
- *Stretch-n-Grow*, a fun fitness programme, Wednesdays 3.00pm to 3.45pm – for children in **Years R, 1 and 2**.
- *Choir*, run by Mrs Rennison, Key Stage 1 Team Leader, supported by other staff, Thursdays 3.00pm to 4.00pm – for children in **Years 1 and 2**. We welcome junior children to this club too. This club is open to existing choir members only until 12<sup>th</sup> October. New members are welcome to join the club after the Basingstoke Variety Show performance on 7<sup>th</sup> October and a separate letter will invite new members at this time.
- *Multi-Skills*, run by SCL, Fridays 3.00pm to 4.00pm – for children in **Years 1 and 2**.

Some infant children also join the junior children in karate club which is held at the junior school on a Monday 4.45 – 5.45pm. If you are interested in this, please contact the regional co-ordinator at Sama Karate Kids on 07759 615876.

Please be reminded of the federation's 50% subsidy for one club for children who have been over the past six years, or currently are, entitled to income-based free school meals. If your child is entitled to the 50% subsidy, please make this clear when you are returning your form and we can then check the entitlement on our computer system and record your payment accordingly. **Payment for all activities can be made in one envelope with the exception of Stretch-n-Grow and Karate.**

Attached is an application form for all the activities that are available. Please hand this to the school by **Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> September**. Please assume your child has been allocated a place unless you hear differently. Places for some of the clubs are limited. If applications outnumber places, we will apply the following criteria:

1. Children who have handed in their application form by the deadline of **Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> September**, irrespective of date of payments made online or at the Federation Admin Office.
2. Places will be allocated so that a child has the opportunity to attend at least one club.
3. If demand still exceeds places preference will be given to Year 2 children.
4. If demand still exceeds places we will draw names out of a hat.

If applications outnumber places for the choir we will decide who can attend based on consideration of the following:

1. Attitude to learning and participation.
2. Reliability with reference to perseverance and attendance.
3. Willingness to practise skills where required.

Can I please ask you to ensure that your application form is returned promptly so that we know which children are attending an activity on a given day and can make sure the children are dismissed to the correct place at the end of the day. Thank you.

All clubs, with the exception of Stretch and Grow and Karate run from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September until Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December. Stretch and Grow will run from 27<sup>th</sup> September to 6<sup>th</sup> December. Karate will start on 18<sup>th</sup> September.

Children who do not have suitable clothing for the activity will not be permitted to take part.

Payment for all clubs can be combined with the exception of Karate and Stretch-n-Grow.
